- **Registration** - Electronic Registration 2019 brings the first year we will be introducing an Electronic Registration form that can be used on all different platforms including your mobile phone. The Electronic Registration form is being introduced to provide better access to data and future opportunities for the QPS RL fraternity.

Registration. Once you have then clicked on the tab you are required to fill in the required fields before submitting your form.

Conduct:

Attendees at the carnival will abide by the Association Rules and By-Laws as set down by the Queensland Police Service Rugby League Association (QPSRLA). Attendees are also required to abide by the Queensland Police Service (QPS) Code of Conduct and are to ensure their behaviour complies with the expectations of the QPS, the QPSRLA and Community Standards. Attendance at the championships may be cancelled by the QPSRLA for breaches of the rules, by-laws or poor behaviour. All attendees are required to submit a registration form on Monday 25 March 2019 at the opening function. Extensive CCTV cameras throughout Hasting Street are operating.

Championship Rules:

1. A player is eligible to play for the Region/District in which he is currently serving OR in the Region/District he was serving as at 1 January 2019. A player may play for another Region/District if there are other unforeseen circumstances e.g. there is no team participating in the relevant carnival from the players Region/District. Consideration may also be given by the match committee to a player who has an ongoing association with a particular team even though he may be attached to another Region/District.
2. Persons other than Police Officers are eligible to play if they agree to abide by the above Rules of Conduct AND the team for which they are playing takes full responsibility for the conduct of that person AND the host club agrees to allow the person/s to participate.
3. Players must use the same jersey number for the entirety of the carnival for state selection purposes. If due to injury or other unforeseen circumstances a jersey number is to be transferred to another player it is the responsibility of the management of that team to advise the selectors.
4. Players diagnosed by a doctor as suffering from the effects of concussion are to take no further part in the carnival unless a written medical clearance has been obtained from a medical practitioner licensed in Queensland.

5. Any player entering or leaving the field of play must report to both the touch judge and referee.
6. Teams must be prepared to take the field at the start time of their allotted game and on the referee's whistle. A team which fails to take the field within five (5) minutes of the referee's final whistle forfeits that game. The four (4) points will automatically be allotted to that team's opponent. A game may still take place after a forfeit with shortened halves however the forfeit still stands regardless of the outcome of the match.
7. If required a Judiciary Committee will be appointed consisting of a convenor and two members appointed by the match committee. No members of the judiciary are to have any direct association with any of the teams competing in the championships. Committee hearings will consist of the Judiciary, the referee/touch judge/s and his/their advocate and the player/s and his/their advocate only. All hearings will be heard at 10.00am the day after the match at the Noosa SLSC (or any other meeting place defined at the discretion of the QPSRLA Executive). If a player fails to attend at that time he will be automatically stood down from the days play and the matter put over the following day at 10.00am. The referee shall present to a match official a written charge regarding any player sent from the field of play. Such report must be submitted within 2 hours of the completion of the final match for the day.
8. Any incident or behaviour contrary to the provisions of the "Queensland Police Service Code of Conduct" will be referred as instructed by those regulations.

Championship Games:

8 Team Draw

4 matches per day over 3 game days

All teams will be placed into the main draw for the first round of matches, with the names drawn out of the hat (or as the host club determines);

- (i) The 4 winners from the remaining games in the first round, will qualify for the semi-final of the State Championship.
- (ii) The 4 losers from the first round will enter the Plate Trophy draw. The winners of these matches will progress directly into the Plate Trophy Final.
- (iii) The winners of the State Championship semi-finals will compete for the State Championships.
- (iv) The losers of the State Championship semi-finals will enter the play-off for third position on the final day of the championship.
- (v) In the case of a draw in any of these games (except the State Championship Final), the winner will be decided as follows:-
 - (a) Most tries scored, then (if equal)
 - (b) 1st try scored, then (if no tries)
 - (c) 1st point scored, then (if no points)

- (d) 5 minutes each way, with the first team to score a point, determined the winner.
- (vi) In the case of a draw in the State Championship Final, there will be a period of 10 minutes each way of “sudden death”, the team to score the first point will be declared the winner. If no points scored after this period, the winner will be declared as in Section (v), sub-sections (a) to (d), above.

This year the 2019 QPSRLA State Carnival will be promoting an emergency services mental health approach via “R U OK?” theme and be assisted by the ‘Men of League Foundation’ and ‘Blue Hope’ organisations.
